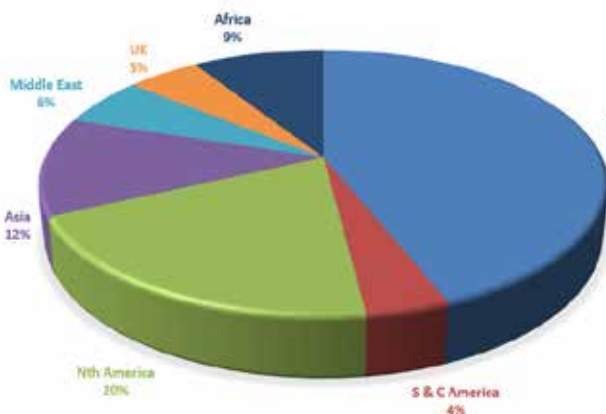

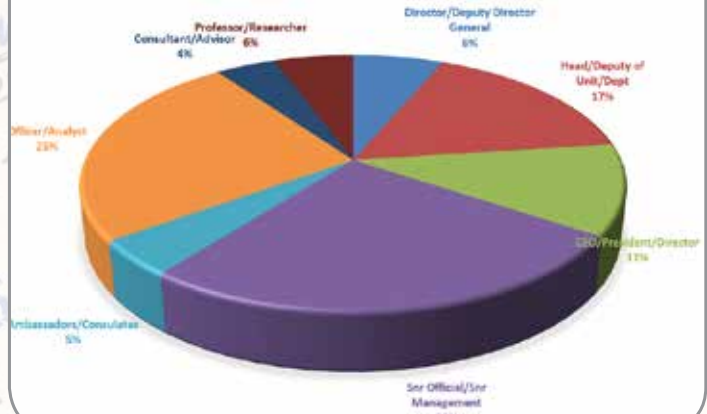

Europol supported a pan-European operation against trafficking of minors for sexual exploitation, forced begging and labour exploitation. Balkan cartel trafficking cocaine around the globe in private planes busted

Operation Familia coordinated by the US DEA and Europol has seen a total of 16 arrests, 11 in Europe and 5 in Asia, and the seizure of more than one tonne of cocaine and €2 million in cash. Law enforcement agencies from across the globe teamed up against a Balkan organised criminal network suspected of



Snapshot: S&T, Israel tackle cargo shipping security

Two tan shipping containers are locked side-by-side on the concrete ground. Each day, thousands of containers travel the globe. Security agencies need to ensure the cargo that originally was shipped in them is what is in them when they reach their destination. Harmful or illegal content, added after the cargo was cleared for transport, must be detected and intercepted. Securing the global supply chain, while ensuring its smooth functioning, is essential to US national security. The Department of Homeland Security Science and Technology Directorate (S&T) and Israel's Ministry of Public Security (MOPPS) teamed up to tackle that issue through the Low Cost Disposable Electronic Seals Pilot.

Migratory situation in July - Arrivals in Europe up slightly from previous month

In July, the number of detections of illegal border crossings on Europe's main migratory routes rose 4% from the previous month to around 10 500. Overall, the total for the first seven months of 2019 was 30% lower than a year ago at around 54 300. The Eastern Mediterranean remained the busiest migratory route into Europe with nearly 5 800 detections in July 2019*. In the first seven months of this year, the total number of detections in this region was down 6% from a year ago to almost 28 200. Despite the overall decrease, the number of arrivals on the Greek islands in the Aegean increased by a quarter in comparison with the same period of last year.
